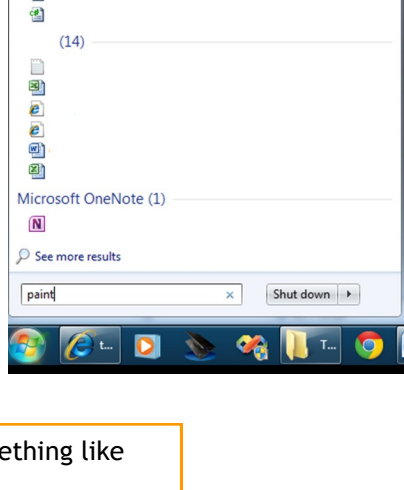



- Go back to the Background Canvas in Paint and paste the image to the background canvas. One way to paste the image is by pressing “CTRL-V” on the keyboard.

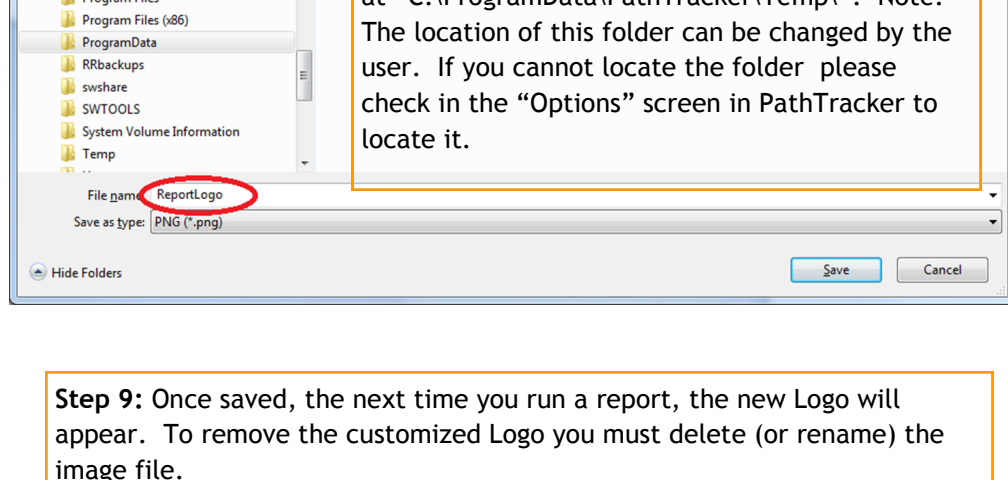
Move the image to a desirable spot by clicking on the image with the mouse and dragging it. The image can also be resized. Resizing the image can result in lost resolution. Please be careful not to select an Image (or Icon) that is already sized to fit the background canvas.
